P3 report, 59% of families have reported hours.

Treasurer: Deanna Moss

Not present, Cassandra gives treasurers report, \$500 requested as discretionary fund for Mr. Morgan. Discussion of whether or not money available to give at this time. Motion and seconded that we give Mr/ Morgan \$500, voted and approved.

Committee Chair Reports:

Principals awards & Honor roll, science fair awards coming up, PTF purchased pins, certificates, etc for awards. Discussion of doing something special for principals honor roll. Options discussed. Cassandra asked for volunteers to help with certificates, printing, etc. Jan 30th as MS 9 am, awards ceremony, Jan 29th at 9 am at ES. Opened up to questions about awards ceremony.

Science Fair committee, headed by Mr. Morgan. Explanation of science fair, awards offered for younger grades as a group and older classes will have individual or group projects. Mr. Morgan explains science fair process for moving on to the next competition level. Kids will be able to take projects home, after our school science fair. Feb. 23rd open house for science fair, judging done during the day at school. First and second place will move on to Lawlor science fair. Gil Delahunt suggests that we get extra help with valet that day to help unload projects. Students will take projects into fellowship hall. Will request help from parents to help set up that day.

Open House committee, Cassandra, open house a great opportunity to share info for next school year. ES Open House, on March 30th and March 31st for MS.

PTF will have information for next year to distribute to families that will be returning next year.

Fundraising Committee, Rhonda will help fill in the gaps on this committee for the remainder of the year and into next year. Jog-a-thon discussed at a better option for raising money for CLEA, instead of a fundraiser dinner, opened up to questions, motion made and seconded that PTF runs a Jog-a-thon instead of a dinner as a fundraiser, voted on by members, motion approved. Mr. Morgan asked that PTF use the money from Jog-a-thon to pay off modulars. Opened up for discussion. Gil asks whether we will take \$2500 year end roll-over funds from Jog-a-thon before paying for Modulars. Motion to use money from Jog-a-thon to pay off modulars, seconded, voted and approved. Motion to pull \$2500 from Jog-a-thon for year end roll-over PTF funds, prior to paying off modulars, seconded, voted on and approved.

Sidebar: discussion of Teacher appreciation gifts, luncheon, etc. Discussion about approaching businesses for gifts for teacher appreciation week.

Cassandra presents YTB fundraiser option to members. Cassandra explains the opportunity, Mr. Morgan explains the business (YTB) and how it works and the benefits to our school. PTF must get approval from CLEA, money made through this is yet to be determined. Motion that PTF pay \$500 for initial startup for YTB Passport to Giving, seconded, voted and approved.

Cassandra moves that we give Christmas Candy Gram profit to the 6th grade for end of the year camping trip, seconded, voted and approved by members.

Valentines gram fundraiser possibly for the 5th grade, Cassandra purchased ringpops for candy grams, will offer them to the 5th grade, as a fundraiser.

Spring book fair, Rhonda asked to run this, and she will. The book fair will happen in March. Discussion of where to hold the book fair, option to hold in Mrs. Arnold's classroom. Book fair will be discussed further at next PTF meeting.
