The following quote from George Washington in 1783 at the end of the Revolutionary War also reminds us how to treat others:

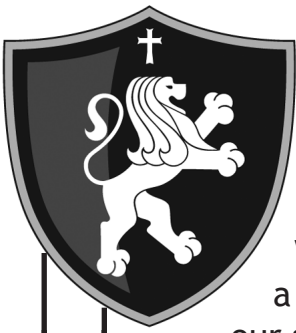
