The Knights Code of Chivalry & the Vows of Knighthood

We will begin our discussion by first commenting on the Knight's vow, "**to obey those placed in authority.**" As always, we turn to God's Word to provide our foundation of understanding. In Ephesians 6:1-2, we are told "**Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this right. Honor your father and mother so that it may be well with you, and that you may live long on the earth.**" This is the first commandment with a promise. Children are to honor their parents for no other reason than that God saw fit to make them their parents. If a child does not honor his parents, then when he is an adult and has children, his authority with them will be built on sand.

Legacy Christian School operates under the legal notion of "**Loco Parentis.**" This may be defined as "instead of parent" and/or "in place of a parent." This simply means, that during the academic day while the student is participating in LCS activities, we represent the parent. Every decision we make, we strive to make in line with the Word of God and as if we were deciding for our very own children. For decisions to have impact however they must be reinforced. We believe the home, the church, and the family are working together to train the children of today and the Christian Leaders of tomorrow: **three separate entities empowered by God to educate the next generation.** Yet, when they work together and support one another in the educational mission, a deeper impact on the student is achieved.

Unfortunately, for a few of our students, this Knightly trait, this directive from God of "obeying those appointed over you" is lacking (at times) in their behavior and conduct. We truly can not accomplish this mission working alone. We need you the parent to reinforce the decisions the Legacy educational team are making. A Legacy Christian School Knight must obey immediately those placed in authority over them. This is not blind obedience. Yet, delayed obedience is disobedience. This immediate act of obedience must come from an attitude of trust and honor. From a heart seeking Jesus and a life totally committed to bringing glory and honor to God. A Knight's mindset is to serve, not be served.

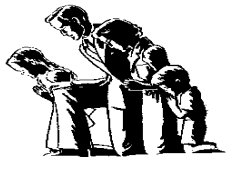
