6th Annual Jog-a-Thon



The 6th Annual Legacy Christian School Jog-a-Thon is October 14th

How does the fundraising aspect of the Jog-a-Thon work?

A jog-a-thon is a great fundraiser in that the students earn the money that is raised by running. It is a school-wide event that fosters a spirit of community, and our students get moving. We would have one even if it did not raise money!!

We use a mail system which allows our families to connect with out of town donors as well as those who live locally.

Your Family Packet has been mailed to you. Once you receive it, fill out and sign the Ice Cream Certificate for

your student to return. They will receive an ice cream bar and we will be assured that all of the Packets have arrived to your homes.

Inside will be a Pledge Contact List. Please list the names and complete addresses of all the people from whom you would like to ask for a donation. Then send it to school with your student. If you have two students, it is only necessary to send it in with one student. When the Pledge Contact List is turned in to the teacher, your child(ren) will receive a Zoo Dude plush toy as a reward for participating in the fundraising aspect of the Jog-a-Thon.

A group of volunteers will then address envelopes to all

of the potential donors using the lists you have provided. We will send a Pledge Request to them (you will receive a sample of this Request in your Packet) with a return addressed envelope. After the Jog-a-thon is over, you will receive a list of all donations made on behalf of your student(s). All donors will receive a thank you letter from the PTF.
