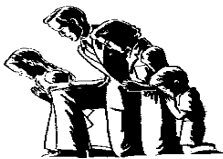
Question: It has been requested to create a Saturday morning version of TableTalk. Please let the office staff know if you would be interested in attending this additional offering?

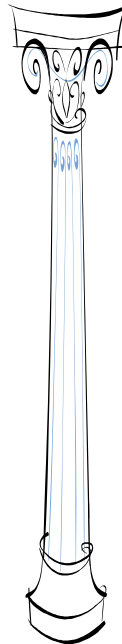
