# ROARING NEWS

In his book, "*Decline and Fall of the Roman Empire*," Edward Gibbon identifies the five major factors for the breakdown and destruction of the Roman civilization. They were:

1. a mounting love of show and luxury (affluence)
2. a widening gap between the very rich and the very poor (people and nations)
3. an obsession with sex
4. freakishness in the arts, masquerading as originality and enthusiasms pretending to be creativity
5. an increased desire to live off the state.



After reading and contemplating over these five descriptive phrases, I think a new book could be written titled, "*The Decline and Fall of the American Nation*." Gibbon's graphic wordage brings up heart rendering visions of what is taking place in America today and I believe a great deal of this decline is because much of the Christian community has become silent.

The Apostle Paul in Ephesians 6:4 tells us that fathers are to take care to bring up their children in "the nurture and admonition of the Lord." While this is taken vaguely by some as an exhortation to "be a Christian dad," others rightly see the words as more pointed than this and assert that Paul is specifically requiring Christian education for the children of Christians. Yet, how many Christian families blindly send their children to a public school system where God is excluded? How many churches fail to speak up when public school leaders articulate curriculum choices that are antagonistic to the Word of God?

Now is the time for the Legacy community to speak up and take action. I challenge you to dive into God's Word and discover the educational mandate He prescribes and then talk to your neighbors about Christian education and the benefits it has produced in your family. I challenge you to talk to your church leaders about supporting Legacy Christian School through mission offerings or scholarships for church members. I challenge you to talk to your local elected officials about making moral decisions instead of expedient ones. I challenge you to live the words found in Philippians 1:27, "**Only conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the gospel of Christ, so that whether I come and see you or remain absent, I will hear of you that you are standing firm in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the faith of the gospel.**"

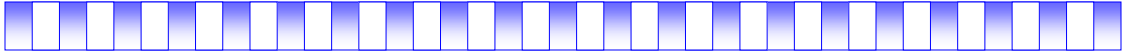
### The Knights Code of Chivalry & the Vows of Knighthood
