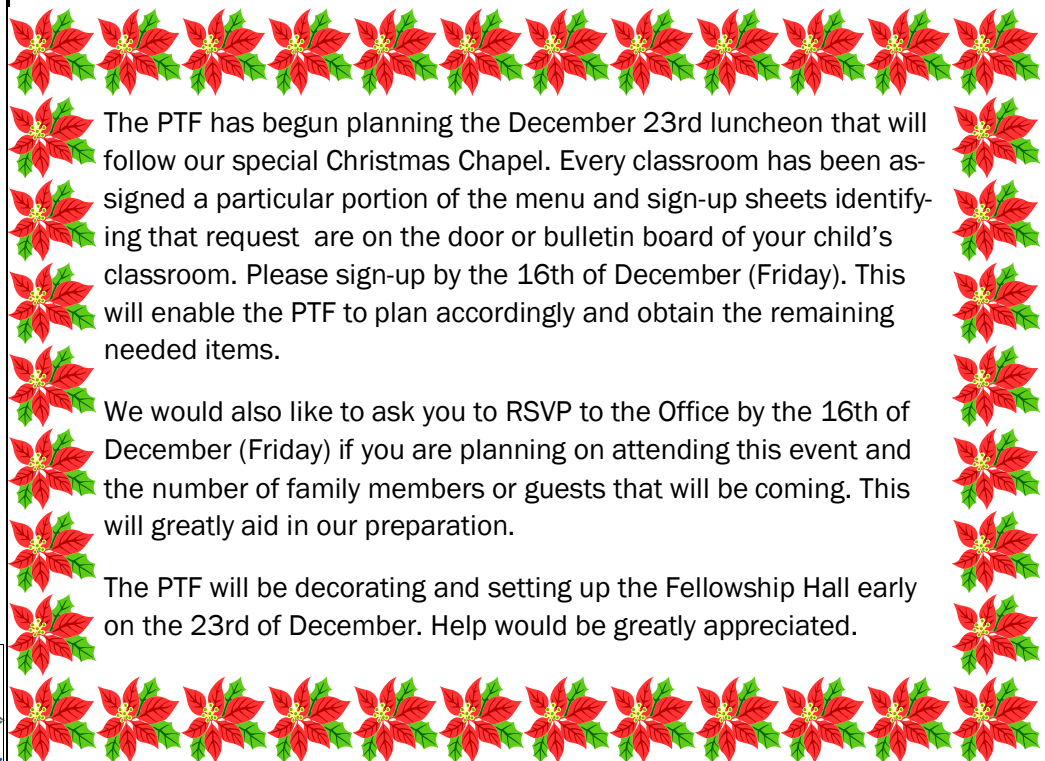
The Knights Code of Chivalry & the Vows of Knighthood
