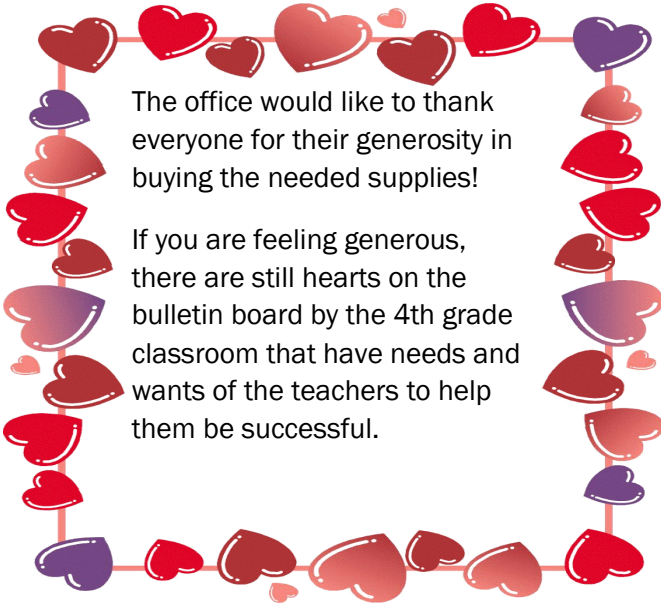




## Valentine's Day Candy Grams
