his faithfulness continues through all generations.

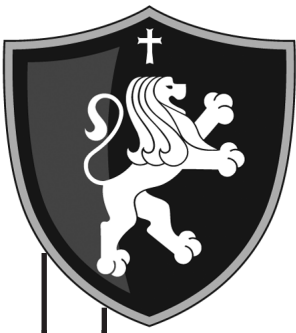

They will be going (roller or ice) skating on PTF!

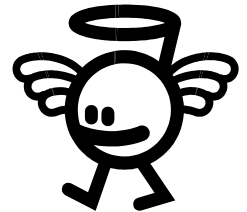
